Clinical Development Service Agency (CDSA)

Registered as a not-for-profit research organization, it aims to develop an eco-system for training and learning and work with public sector institutions, and small and medium enterprises (SME) to translate innovative technologies into medical products for the public good (<http://www.cdsaindia.in>).

COE Program

COE program aims to provide an opportunity for individual COE to build capacity and capability in the area of clinical research. This program is for clinical researchers, investigators and other personnel from India in becoming capable of conducting clinical and epidemiological research. COE program is based on training needs assessment also identifying the gaps & need for achieving clinical research excellence in the country. The program is organized by COE for collaboration in education, training and capacity building and collaboration in research, innovation, and is coordinated by CDSA on behalf of the COE. This program includes short-term training and workshops referred to as COE program in the fields of epidemiology, public health research, clinical research methods, research data management & analysis, good clinical practice and ethics in research involving human subjects. The courses are either

independently conducted by COE members or are jointly by one or more members of COE along with the CDSA.
